- Operating a cutting torch
- Occasionally operating an ironworker punching holes and shearing steel
- Occasionally operating a band saw
- Operating a forklift
- Keep yard and warehouse clean and organized

REQUIRED QUALIFICATION(S): (required qualification for the job)

- The ability to read a tape measure and perform simple calculations
- Willingness to work outside in all types of weather
